The MIX SOUTH has 2 sessions left this term and we will be having themes of Easter and Games so if you would like to know more information about the group please contact

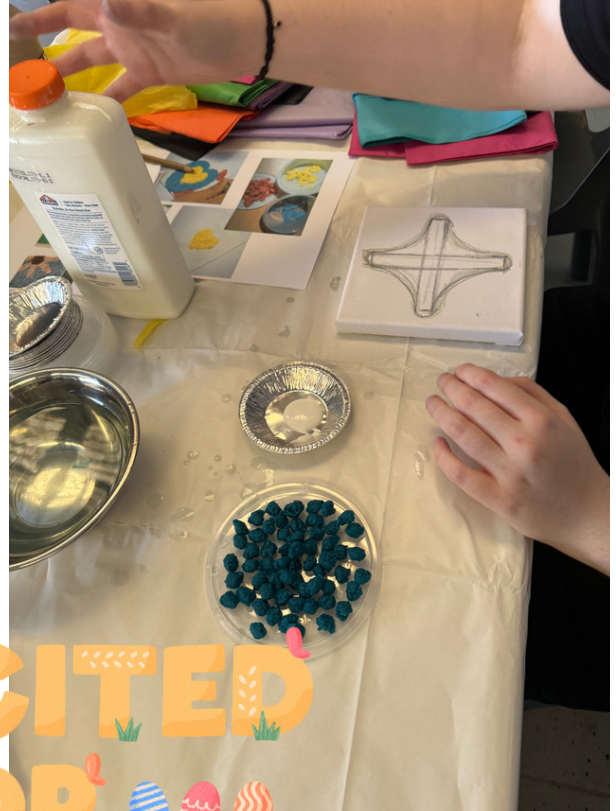

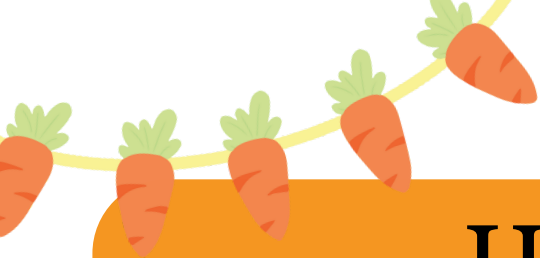

Harmony Day

In 1999, the Howard government in Australia introduced 'Harmony Day', to commemorate the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination, focusing on building a more united multicultural society. The Department of Home Affairs takes the lead in Australia in celebrating Harmony Week, which is all about recognising and celebrating diversity, with inclusion activities happening throughout the entire week.

In 2019, the Department of Home Affairs expanded the celebration, rebranding it as 'Harmony Week' to better acknowledge the diversity and inclusion activities occurring throughout the week, particularly in schools and workplaces. Harmony Week, celebrated from Monday to Sunday during the week that includes March 21, is dedicated to celebrating Australia's rich multicultural heritage. This year, under the theme "Everyone Belongs," Harmony Week is scheduled from Monday, March 18 to Sunday, March 24

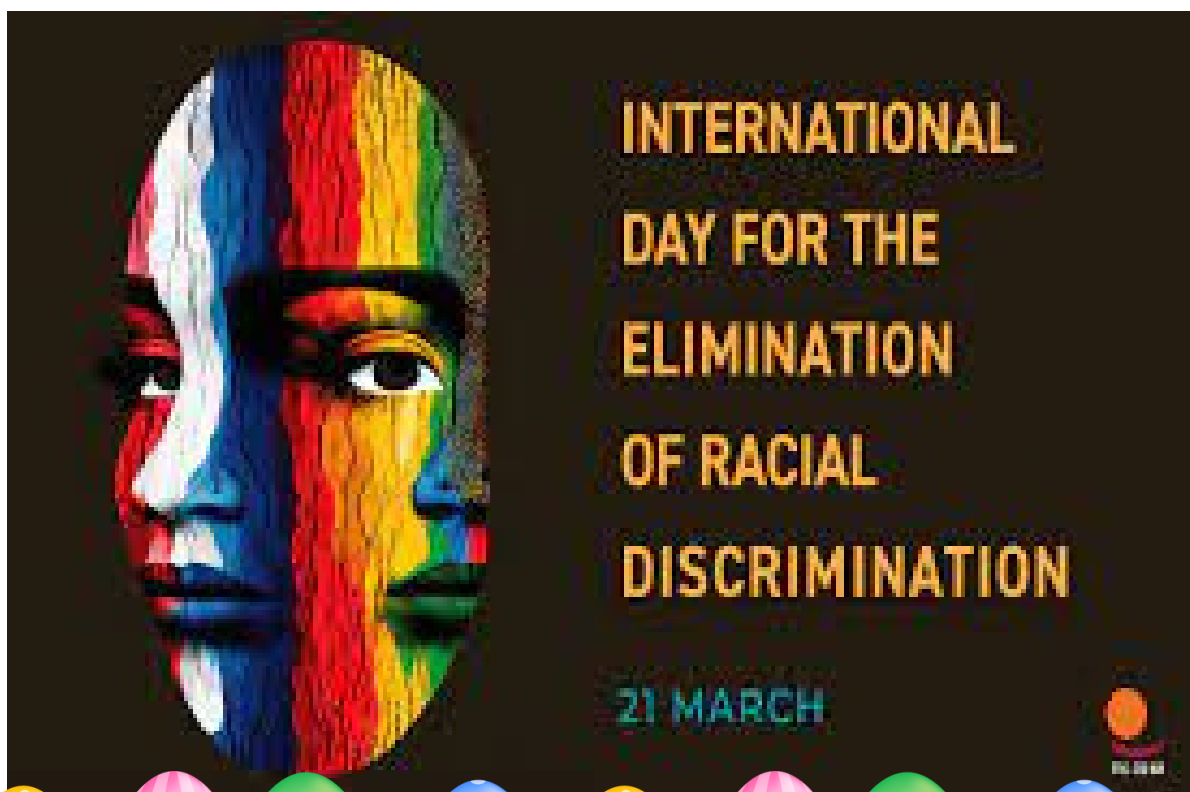
The international Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination
